E1 TO ELECT A CHAIR

Cllr Thirlaway was nominated by Cllr Dunn and was elected as Chair.

E2 TO RECEIVE APOLOGIES AND TO APPROVE REASONS FOR ABSENCE

No apologies were received.

E3 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST IN ITEMS ON THE AGENDA

No declarations of interest were received.

E4 ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE TERMS OF REFERENCE

The Clerk had not been able to circulate a draft due to time pressures. **RESOLVED** to defer to the next meeting.

E5 REVIEW OF PARISH COUNCIL LAND OWNERSHIP AND LEASE ARRANGEMENTS

Members considered a list of the land owned or leased by the Parish Council. The Clerk advised she will check this with the solicitor to ensure everything is included. Cllr Dunn proposed the Council write to Legal & General to ask them to donate to the Council a small area they own and this was **RESOLVED**.

E6 UPDATE AND REVIEW OF ACTIVITY IN THE PARISH IN RELATION TO THE ENVIRONMENT

Grit bins

Cllr Dunn advised this is in progress.

Cricket Ground

The Clerk advised that as reported to the full Council on 3rd October asbestos has been found; one quote for removal has been received and she is seeking further quotes.

St Mary's Churchyard

Members **RESOLVED** the Clerk to obtain the title deed to check ownership in the area and clarify to the next meeting.

Parking Update

Cllr Hepplewhite asked about publicity for the public meeting on parking and Cllr Dunn advised that publicity has been done via social media and that he will be putting up posters around the village. Cllr Dunn advised that the landowner behind Cornforth Lane does not wish to sell any land that could potentially be used for parking.

Villages' Appearance and Cleanliness

Members discussed land at Hawthorn Crescent and Belle Vue in Quarrington Hill. Members discussed the former Co-op site and it was **RESOLVED** that Cllr Thirlaway make further enquiries and report back.

Village Greens' Power Supplies

Cllr Dunn reported that St Joseph's Church has agreed to the siting of the power supply requested by the Parish Council.

Wildflower Planting

The Clerk advised the Grounds Maintenance Contractor will be planting the seeds on the village greens in Coxhoe. Cllr Thirlaway said he is still to undertake a survey of footpaths. Solar powered lampposts were discussed and Cllr Thirlaway said he will circulate details of these.

Members **RESOLVED** the information on activity in relation to the environment is noted.

E7 **GROUNDS MAINTENANCE CONTRACT**

The Clerk had circulated copies of the last grounds maintenance tender and schedule and requested feedback on these ahead of the tender which is due for renewal by April 2019. Cllr Dunn said paths and plans are missing and he will provide information on public rights of way. Members **RESOLVED (A)** that they would provide feedback to the Clerk by the end of this month. Members **RESOLVED (B)** the Clerk to give to the next meeting a timescale for the tender exercise.
